COLLUS Power Distribution Rates and other Electricity Charges

In August 2009 COLLUS Power submitted a 2010 rate application to the Ontario Energy Board and following a review of the detailed evidence the OEB has approved new Distribution Rates for implementation beginning May 1, 2010.

For the average Residential Customer billed on 800kWh's per month, the Distribution component of the bill will go down by 9.7% from \$24.83 to \$22.63.

COLLUS Power Combined rates remain amongst the lowest when compared to local neighbouring utilities and large centers that many of our local part-time residents call home.

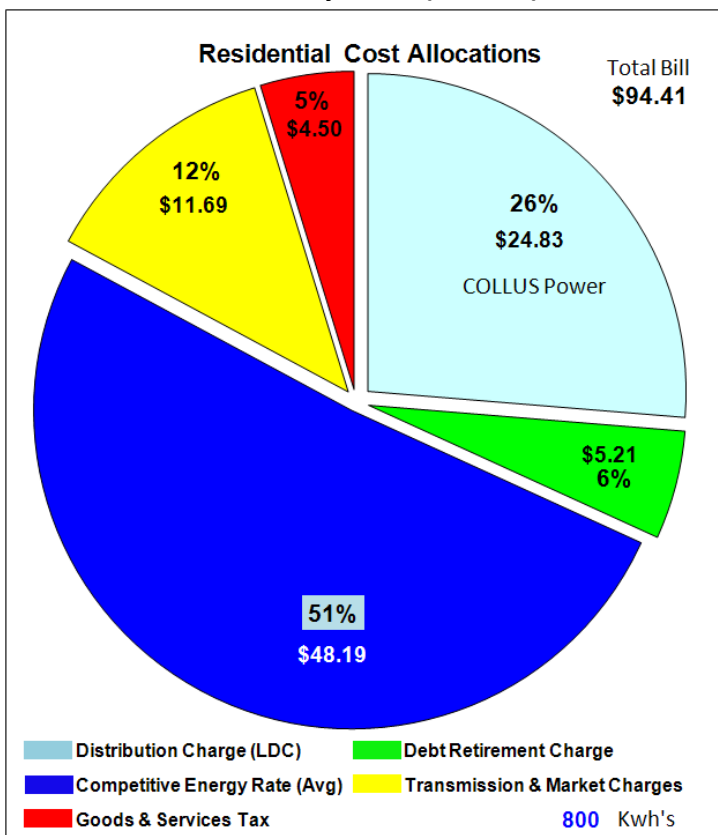

In addition to the local costs related to the distribution of electricity to our customers, COLLUS Power is also responsible for the collection of other charges ie: Transmission, Debt Retirement, Energy and GST.

Recently the Ontario Energy Board announced Regulated Price Plan increases beginning on May 1, 2010. These increases are primarily driven to cover the cost of Conservation Programs and the contract prices for new Renewable Generation across the Province.

In addition to the increases to the Regulated Price Plan energy rates, consumers will also be faced with the introduction of HST beginning July 1, 2010.
